SAMA-Bedford's current installment of art in our first floor Titelman Galleries is Landscapes and Urbanscapes from SAMA's extensive permanent collection. It is a veritable medium smorgasbord for the viewer's eye, ranging from lithographs and pencil drawings to oils and watercolors.

On exhibit in the Paula & Dean Lemley Gallery, is a sampling of posters from the Mark del Costello Collection. This eclectic compilation focuses on American graphic design of the modern era.
