BEDFORD SAMA TO OFFER KIDS' BRACELET WEAVING WORKSHOP**

Bedford – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Bedford is hosting a fun, hands-on workshop for children to learn weaving through bracelet-making on Saturday, March 16th, from 1:00 – 3:00 p.m. Students will get the chance to try several techniques, including knotting and embellishing, to craft unique friendship bracelets. In addition to the class that afternoon, students can spend time exploring the *Hands-On* exhibit in the regional galleries. One of the featured artists, Nancy Hershberger, will be displaying a variety of textile and fiber art. Her passion for fiber craft can be an inspiration to budding weavers! Cost is \$55 (non-member) or \$45 (member) per child. Ages 5 – 15 are welcome—there will be separate age-appropriate groups for those 5-9 or 10-15. All materials will be supplied.
