**STUDENT ARTISTS STILL BEING ACCEPTED FOR SPECIAL *ART OF HOCKEY* EXHIBITION CENTERED ON KRAFT HOCKEYVILLE CELEBRATION**

Johnstown – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art (SAMA) is still accepting student art entries for a special *Art of Hockey* exhibition that will be on view as part of the official Kraft Hockeyville celebration in late September. The student-created works will be on display at the Pasquerilla Conference Center in Downtown Johnstown on September 28 and 29. The Conference Center will be the host venue for the Johnstown Tomahawks’ fundraiser gala on September 28 and a viewing party for the NHL preseason game between the Pittsburgh Penguins and Tampa Bay Lightning at the Cambria County War Memorial Arena on September 29.

The exhibition is open to any interested school or student, grades K-12. Works may feature Penguins or Lightning players or logos, NBC Sports personalities or logo, the NHL Shield logo, and themes reflecting Johnstown’s rich hockey heritage (Tomahawks, Chiefs, Jets, high school hockey, etc.). Students may be provided with specific Penguins and Lightning images approved by the NHL and NHLPA by accessing the “Community” tab on [JohnstownTomahawks.com](http://JohnstownTomahawks.com).

All entries must be delivered to the Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Johnstown, located on the University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown campus, between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on September 21.
