SAMA AUXILIARY PLANS VISIT TO PHILADELPHIA FLOWER SHOW

Altoona – The Auxiliary of the Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art is planning a bus trip to visit the 2012 Philadelphia International Flower Show on March 6. The Philadelphia International Flower Show is considered the premier gardening event of its kind in the world in part because of the diversity of the plants. The 2012 show, “Hawaii: Islands of Aloha,” will introduce visitors to a tropical experience that blends next-stage digital technology with the natural beauty and rich culture of the Hawaiian Islands. Guests will have fun, learn, and be wowed by real-time floral competitions, the world’s largest lettuce wall, internationally renowned speakers, and a new layout of displays.
