ALTOONA MUSEUM PLANS VISIT TO PHILADELPHIA FLOWER SHOW

Altoona – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Altoona is planning a bus trip to visit the 2017 PHS Philadelphia Flower Show on March 14. Cost is \$110 per person, with a \$50 non-refundable deposit due with reservation. Space is limited. Reservations are requested by March 1.

The world's longest running and largest indoor flower show, this year the Philadelphia Flower Show presents "Holland: Flowering the World." The show will celebrate the beauty and ingenuity of Dutch culture, from vivid flower fields to innovative eco-design. Visitors will travel through the Netherlands, from the canals of Amsterdam to castle gardens and world renowned art, all while experiencing acres of breath-taking gardens, landscapes and floral designs.
