MUSEUM NAMES CHAIRS FOR 2013 GARDEN PARTY

Ligonier – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Ligonier Valley has announced that Joyce Collins and Peggy Shepler will serve as co-chairs for the Museum’s twelfth annual Garden Party. SAMA’s Garden Party will be held on Saturday, June 1.

Collins, of Ligonier, is marking her first time chairing the Garden Party. She is active in the Museum’s Auxiliary, currently serving as Secretary. She performs volunteer work with the Valley Senior Center of Ligonier and also serves as a volunteer usher for the Valley Players of Ligonier. Collins is a native of Montana and was active with a number of boards and organizations in her home state.

Shepler, also from Ligonier, is serving her second term as Garden Party chair, previously holding the position for the 2010 event. She is active in the Museum’s Auxiliary and has been involved with the Fort Ligonier Days Parade for ten years. Shepler formerly served as Secretary of the Ligonier Borough Planning Commission for several years and is active in numerous organizations. Currently she is Vice President of the Chestnut Ridge Historical Society, also serving on its Board of Directors as Vice Chairman.
