### **SAMA GARDENS RECEIVE SCULPTURE DONATION**

Ligonier – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Ligonier Valley received a sculpture donation this summer to enhance its flower gardens. Ann Hewat of Ligonier donated *Noah's Ark* in memory of Doris Mullan. The sculpture came from Main Exhibit Gallery and was created by Ohio artist Don Drumm and fabricated by Cricket Forge. The sculpture is made of ¼ inch steel, galvanized to prevent rust, and then painted with a base coat and finally, hand-painted.
