**CENTRAL PENNSYLVANIA ARTIST TO SPEAK AT SAMA-ALTOONA  
LUNCH PROGRAM**

Altoona – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Altoona will host a Lunch a l'Art program with exhibiting artist Adam Gundy on Wednesday, October 22. The program, which begins at noon, includes lunch and a presentation by the artist. Cost is \$15 per person or \$14 for SAMA members. Please call the Museum at (814) 946-4464 for reservations.

Gundy, of Lock Haven, has literally made a permanent mark with his art. The artist is best known for integrating the use of permanent markers and '50s- and '60s-inspired graphics into his posters that advertise local music performances. Forty-one of Gundy's posters are currently featured in the exhibition, *Adam Gundy: We're All Groupies*, on view through January 10, 2015.

Lunch a l'Art programs are offered to encourage a greater understanding of various art forms and movements, as well as foster a deeper appreciation for the exhibitions presented by the Museum.

The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Altoona is located in the Brett Building at 1210 Eleventh Avenue. Hours of operation are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Friday and 1 to 5 p.m. Saturday. The Museum is a handicapped-accessible facility and is open to the public free of charge.
