**ALTOONA MUSEUM TO HOST LUNCH A L'ART WITH COLLECTOR  
JOHN ORR**

Altoona – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Altoona will host a Lunch a l'Art program with art collector John Orr on Thursday, February 12. The program begins at noon and includes lunch and a presentation by Orr. Cost is \$15 or \$14 for SAMA members. Please call the Museum at (814) 946-4464 for reservations or additional information.

The program is in conjunction with the Museum's present exhibition, *The Heart and Soul of Olga and John Orr*. The exhibition features thirty-five works from the Orrs' private collection. The collection features a variety of contemporary works and places an emphasis on local and regional artists including Jory Albright, Frederick Counsel, Steve Gilbert, Helen Gorsuch, Joe Servello and S. Scott Steberger. *The Heart and Soul of Olga and John Orr* will remain on view through March 14.

Lunch a l'Art programs are offered to encourage a greater understanding of various art forms and movements, as well as foster a deeper appreciation for the exhibitions presented by the Museum.

The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Altoona is located in the Brett Building at 1210 Eleventh Avenue. Hours of operation are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Friday and 1 to 5 p.m. Saturday.
