JOHNSTOWN MUSEUM TO HOST LUNCH PROGRAM

Johnstown – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Johnstown will host a Lunch a l' Art program on Tuesday, February 14. The program begins at noon and includes lunch and a gallery tour and discussion by Museum Coordinator Tine Lehman. Cost is \$9 per person. The program will center around the Museum's current exhibition, *Seasons of Western Pennsylvania: The Photography of Donald M. Robinson*. An award-winning Pittsburgh photographer, Robinson has traveled the world in search of spectacular views, yet has found some of his most breath-taking subjects in his own backyard. Robinson is renowned for his technical mastery and keen artistic sense. The exhibition will remain on view through April 28.
