**FAMED PARANORMAL RESEARCHER TO SPEAK AT LIGONIER
VALLEY MUSEUM**

Ligonier – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Ligonier Valley will welcome famed paranormal and UFO researcher Stan Gordon for a special presentation on Wednesday, April 13. Cost for the program, which begins at 6 p.m., is \$5 per person. Reservations are requested by April 11 by calling the Museum at (724) 238-6015.

Gordon will present an illustrated lecture titled “Strange Encounters of Pennsylvania.” The presentation will cover a number of UFO, Bigfoot and other strange incidents that have been reported in Westmoreland County and Western Pennsylvania. He will focus on the 1965 UFO crash-landing near Kecksburg, and will also discuss the mysterious “boom” sounds heard recently in the area and throughout the United States. Gordon will be available to meet with guests after the program and will be signing copies of his books and DVDs.

Gordon has been researching UFO sightings and other mysterious events since 1959. He is the producer of the award-winning documentary “Kecksburg: The Untold Story” and is the author of three books. Gordon appears frequently on radio and television programs and has been seen on the History, Discovery, SyFy, Science, Travel and Destination America channels. He has been a frequent guest on the popular late-night radio talk show, Coast to Coast AM.

The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Ligonier Valley is located at One Boucher Lane and Route 711 South in Ligonier.
