**UFO AND PARANORMAL RESEARCHER STAN GORDON TO MAKE  
RETURN APPEARANCE AT LIGONIER VALLEY MUSEUM**

Ligonier – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Ligonier Valley will welcome back renowned paranormal and UFO researcher Stan Gordon for a special presentation on Wednesday, March 15. Cost for the program, which begins at 6 p.m., is \$5 per person. Reservations are requested by March 14 by calling the Museum at (724) 238-6015.

At this all-new program, Gordon will provide an in-depth examination into the 1965 UFO crash-landing near Kecksburg. Additionally, he will reveal details about recent UFO and Bigfoot sightings in the Ligonier area. A question-and-answer period will follow the presentation, and Gordon will be available to meet with guests and will be signing copies of his books and DVDs.

Gordon has been researching UFO sightings and other mysterious events since 1959. He is the producer of the award-winning documentary “Kecksburg: The Untold Story” and is the author of three books. Gordon appears frequently on radio and television programs and has been seen on the History, Discovery, SyFy, Science, Travel and Destination America channels. He has been a frequent guest on the popular late-night radio talk show, Coast to Coast AM.
