### **ALTOONA MUSEUM TO HOST FINAL *WICKED WEDNESDAY* OF 2015**

Altoona – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Altoona will close out its 2015 *Wicked Wednesday* series on October 14. The program, which begins at 6 p.m., offers the region’s best musical, culinary and fine arts in one setting. Each *Wicked Wednesday* program includes light supper and libations while guests listen to the area’s finest musical talent. Additionally, each program highlights the Museum’s latest exhibitions.

The October 14 program will include a performance by Mountain City Grass. A traditional bluegrass group based out of Central Pennsylvania, Mountain City Grass consists of Denny Cerully on vocals and guitar, Katie Cerully on bass and vocals, Ed Decker on guitar and vocals, Dean Berkheimer on banjo, and Jason Dodson on fiddle.

Guests at *Wicked Wednesday* also will have an opportunity to view the Museum’s latest exhibitions, *Artists in Our Midst* and *Paper and Fire: Prints by Leonard Baskin*. Highlighting work by artists from the regional art group Art in Common, *Artists in Our Midst* features 63 works in a wide variety of media. *Paper and Fire* offers nearly 60 works, many of them making their SAMA debut, by renowned printmaker Leonard Baskin.
