LORETTO MUSEUM TO HOST DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP FOR ARTISTS AND EDUCATORS

Loretto – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Loretto will host a professional development workshop for teachers and artists on Monday, March 20. The program is titled "Creativity and Empowerment: Story Sharing with Elders" and will be led by Jennifer Hill, a teaching artist with York Cultural Alliance.

During the one-day session, guests will learn the empowering benefits of reminiscence and story sharing for the elderly population.
